

Eagle Court of Honor Candidate Worksheet

I do not need your merit badges or your rank advancement history, as I already have that information. Nor do I need your home address or date of birth. However, please provide all of the following information to the best of your ability. Keep in mind that you may not be able to provide information to every question. These are here to help guide you in providing information. Some of this information, including your brief biography and information regarding your service project, will be provided to other parties (speakers at the Eagle Court of Honor) and used to write a newspaper article.

Biographical Information

1. Full name and name you preferred to be called.
2. Who you wish to dub you Eagle.
3. Your parents' full names.
4. Brief biography.
5. Favorite hobbies/activities, likes & dislikes, aspirations, defining moments.
6. Anything else you are particularly proud of, or is of interest.

Scout Information

1. Cub Pack you came from.
2. Yawgoog segments awarded.
3. Any other recognition that you've received in Scouts (religious medals, translator, OA, etc.).
4. All leadership positions. Your memory may be more accurate than my records.

Academic Information

1. School you attend and current year (e.g. Sophomore/Junior).
2. Any honors you have achieved at school.
3. Any sports you participate in – at school or in a city program, etc.
4. Any other extracurricular activities that you participate in.
5. Any recognition that you've received outside of Scouts (community groups, etc.)

Service Project Information

1. Complete the information on the back of this sheet and return or e-mail.

Photographs

Please provide the Scoutmaster with 10-12 photographs of the Eagle candidate. These should include scouting photos that cover his entire time in Scouts, including Cub Scouts, if possible. They may also include other appropriate photos, if desired. Digital photos may be provided to the Scoutmaster via email. If you intend on scanning the photos yourself (not recommended), scan the photos in at 24 bit color at 150-200 dpi. If this doesn't make sense, don't scan them yourself. I need these photos at least two weeks prior to the ceremony. Call me at 679-0035 with any questions.

Do not feel you need to re-type all this information. If you have some or all of this already compiled for your Eagle application, you may provide that.
